“Greetings from Spain” Art Competition Rules:

Media: Artists submitting flat artwork may use any type of drawing tool, pastel, paint, or collage. Heavier weight papers or illustration board are preferred, as thinner papers are more likely to be damaged. If the finished artwork is easily smudged, please affix a cover sheet to protect it.

Framing and labeling: All artwork is to be submitted **unframed** and **unsigned**. Your artwork will be assigned a number which the judges will use to identify it.

Subject matter: All artwork must clearly depict an image that evokes an association with Spanish history, architecture, landscape, fashion, music, culture, etc.

Prizes: Selected works will be chosen to be made into a set of postcards.

All works will be displayed at MUSYCA’s upcoming concert.

Participants will receive 2 complementary tickets to MUSYCA Concert.

All artists will receive Certificates of Participation and will have an opportunity to participate in the art masterclass.

Submission/Deadline: In response to COVID-19 we are accepting email submissions this year. Please email us a photo of your work. All artwork must be submitted with a completed registration form and entry fee of \$20.00 per piece by May 1, 2020 to sing@musyca.org.
